CaseXport embeds the data within the eCRFs (PDF forms) along with all of the visual indicators of changes, closed queries, signature status, source document verification status, etc. Screens are linked to queries and the site audit trail. The submission-ready application runs in a standalone environment on most Windows computers and requires no Internet connection. CaseXport is delivered to the customer in the form of CDs or DVDs. The eCRFs can be exported as PDF formatted files with index embedded data for ease of import into a document management system for preparation of submission.
